Candidate Program

We congratulate you on becoming a Candidate for Freemasonry at _____ Lodge! You are about to join the world's oldest and largest fraternity.

There are three steps to gaining full membership in the Masonic Fraternity: Entered Apprenticed Mason, Fellowcraft Mason, and Master Mason. Each one of these steps is an initiatory process – called “Degrees” – wherein you will advance by your abilities and by fulfilling certain requirements.

The Candidate Program established at our Lodge is in place to assist you on your journey in becoming a Master Mason and fully knowledgeable about Freemasonry. Our goal through this program is to make sure that you become an active member, not merely a member who pays dues on an annual basis. Here, you will make lifelong friendships and live in the tradition of our ancient brethren – where we work together, have fun together, assist each other and look after each other.

You have been elected to membership in our Lodge and you are now a Candidate. Shortly, the Master of the Lodge will schedule your First Degree, where you will become an Entered Apprenticed Mason. Below you will find the requirements that you will need to fulfill as you make your journey to become a Master Mason. This is only an outline of the ritualistic, fraternal and lodge oriented requirements that you will need to complete in becoming a Master Mason. If you have any questions about the Candidate Program, we invite you to ask without hesitation.

PROGRAM OUTLINE:

1. The Master Mason who provides an Application for Degrees to a prospect cannot sign the Application as one of the Recommenders, unless he is a close relative.
 - A prospect cannot be provided an Application at the first Lodge event at which he attends, but must attend _____ predetermined events before eligibility to receive an Application
2. Upon submission of Application for Degrees
 - The Applicant will be required to attend the Stated Meeting dinner at which he submits his Application
 - The Applicant will be encouraged to attend all other Degree dinners, social events, Family Night Dinners, fundraisers and other activities of the Lodge to get to know Lodge members

3. Stated Meeting at which the Lodge will vote on the Applicant

- The Applicant will be required to attend the Stated Meeting dinner at which a vote is taken on his Application
- The Applicant will be required to remain at the Lodge during the Stated Meeting until the vote is taken on his Application
- Upon election of an Applicant, the Lodge will be called to Refreshment and the Candidate will be escorted into the Lodge by the Marshal to a place west of the Altar
- From the East, the Master will announce the results of the ballot and then call the Wardens to meet him West of the Altar to congratulate the Candidate
- The new Candidate will be presented a chain of seven (7) links by the Master and given the rules of the chains
- The Candidate will be congratulated and escorted out of the Lodge by the Marshal
- The Candidate will remain in the Lodge building to participate in the social event after the Stated Meeting

4. After Election and before receiving the First Degree

- The Candidate will be required to carry his chain of links at all times
- The Candidate will be required to attend _____ Stated Meeting dinners, to work in the kitchen after the dinner and to attend the event planned after the conclusion of the Stated Meeting
- The Candidate will be required to attend all First Degree dinners and assist in the kitchen after the dinner
- The Candidate will be required to attend _____ Family Night dinners and serve as a Lodge "greeter" in the foyer
- The Candidate will be required to attend at least _____ Social Night events and assist in the kitchen after the dinner
- The Candidate will be required to attend _____ fundraiser events and assist in the kitchen when needed

5. Upon receiving the First Degree

- The Candidate will be required to carry his chain of links at all times
- The Candidate will be required to attend all Stated Meeting dinners, to work in the kitchen after the dinner and to attend the event planned after the conclusion of the Stated Meeting
